Mr. Pitoynak was requested to wear a mask, would not comply, requested him to leave unless he would wear a mask and left.
5. **New Business:**  
Northwest Insurance Agent, Jeffrey Evans – discussed the renewal for the 2021, with the current policy of an increase of 10.05% vs the other policy of -2.58%. Discussion regarding the coverage and costs for the Borough and employees, Beneflex and the HRA. Motion made by Mr. Petrini, seconded by Mrs. Lijewski to approve Northwest Insurance plan UPMC – Gold 2020 HSA PPO \$2,000. No further discussion, motion carries.
6. **Approve Agenda:** Motion made by Mrs. Lijewski, seconded by Mr. Petrini the agenda for 10/28/2020, no further discussion, motion carries.
7. **Citizens to address Council:**
  - a. Larry Owens, Sr. 2227 Eastern Avenue – Here to discuss a concern about parking, specifically for his handicap parking for his mother’s caregiver. He believed that the odd/even parking was not in effect because of COVID. He stated that he called and was told it was on the website, and why would he check the website for that. Wanted to know why the Officer would not give a courtesy that as of October 15<sup>th</sup> that the odd/even parking would be enforced. Mr. Briggs explained that the Council can not tell any Officer or the Chief what to do in regards to the Police policies. Discussion regarding notification to residents, discussion with Chief Schulz and having a hearing at the District Justice. Mr. Owens has already paid for the ticket but believes that there should have been a courtesy. Explained that the parking odd/even was relaxed from March due to COVID. Mr. Owens will come in to talk to Chief Schulz tomorrow.

  - a. Present Proposed 2021 Budget, Council Members to review. Discussion of potential expenses.
  - b. Transfer from the PLGIT State Road Grant Transferred to Northwest General Checking account in the amount of \$97,545.39 to cover road repairs done.

  - d. Discussed the CARES grant due on November 16<sup>th</sup>.
  - e. Request from the Girl Scouts to use the hall on November 5<sup>th</sup>. Due to COVID restrictions, and there would be 15 to 20 people, Council advised that the use of the hall would not be available
  - f. Mr. Petrini relayed the information from Joe Berdis the application for Elderly LMI housing repairs.
