4. **Roll Call:**

5. **Citizens to Address Council: (5-minute time limit per signed-in citizen)**
 - a. Tom McShane – 2121 Eastern Avenue – Came to office to on 3/8/2022 to apply for a zoning permit but would need to file a variance. Was explained that since there was not a Zoning Hearing Board a need for direction from Council would be needed. Mr. Betza stated that a Zoning Hearing Board is immediately necessary and Mr. McShane would have to file a variance.

 - d. Motion made by Mr. Silbaugh seconded by Mr. Wilder to retroactively pay assistant supervisor Shawn Hess. When discussed in November with the Personnel Committee the assistant secretary wages would increase by \$4.00. When the motion was made the hourly wage was stated to be \$17.00, should have been \$17.71. Retroactive pay from 2/1/2022 of .71 per hour. No further discussion unanimous voice vote, motion carries.
 - e. Motion made by Mr. Petrini seconded by Mr. Wilder to approve invoice from Amendola Construction to repair manhole replacement at Market and North Street. Will be paid from the Sewer Fund. Submit to insurance company. No further discussion, unanimous voice vote, motion carries.
