 - i) The Borough's need for an audit was advertised in the paper, 3 proposals were ultimately received. From, Heberlein & Falk (\$10,000), MaherDuessel (\$16,000), McGill, Power, Bell & Associates (\$22,000).
- c. Motion to approve of extending an offer of employment to Carlos Cruz-Cooney for the position of Police Officer in the Wesleyville Police Department on condition of passing the background check, made by Mrs. Kolessar, seconded by Mr. Wilder, passed unanimously.
- d. Motion to approve of transferring several computers and monitors to the Wesleyville Hose Company, made by Mr. Petrini, seconded by Mr. Wilder, passed unanimously.
 - i) We are upgrading all of ours due to a grant so we will not be needing these additional PCs.
- e. Motion to approve the signing of the written approval for Manager Jacobs' anticipated Erie County Council run, made by Mrs. Kolesar, seconded by Mr. Wilder, passed unanimously.
